* Although the wording is a bit ambiguous, based on the marriages of an Elizabeth Knowles 28 Apr 1746 in Forncett St. Peter (PR BMB 1718-1770), and one 16 Sep 1753 in Bunwell, (ArchD 1725 FS i#16) it seems more likely that the second Elizabeth who was married in Bunwell was the mother of the "Mary Knowles the daughter of Elizabeth" as described in William's will. Thus a great granddaughter of William rather than a granddaughter.
