Instructions for cutting one set of quilting frames out of one sheet of $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ plywood:
Cut a $4^{\prime} \times 8$ ' sheet of $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ plywood according to the gross dimensions shown
below. The cutouts marked 1a and 1b interconnect to serve as one of 4 main supports.
Those marked $2 \mathrm{a} \& 2 \mathrm{~b}, 3 \mathrm{a} \& 3 \mathrm{~b}, 4 \mathrm{a}$ \& 4 b interconnect to serve as the other 3 main supports.
Those marked (5a) \& (5b), (6a) \& (6b) may be used to make optional additional supports.
